Selection criteria for Local April Start Students (Year 12)

All Students

In view of the additional pressure on students because of the late start and the limited choice of academic subjects available, students will be selected for this program according to the following criteria:

1. You are university bound or entering TAFEWA.
2. You have **recent, relevant** background at Year 11 or Year 12 level. Evidence of academic background should be available at interview. Minimum requirement is a 'C' at Year 11 level. Background is **essential** for Physics, Chemistry, all Mathematics subjects.
3. You are sufficiently motivated to cope with the rigour of an intensive 28 week program. You are advised to take the minimum number of subjects required to meet university/TAFEWA admission requirements.

School Leaver – If under 19 as of 1 March 2010.

It must be possible for you to gain entry to the university/TAFEWA course of your choice by enrolling in no more than four (4) subjects. This may be varied in exceptional circumstances. Factors to be considered include:

- Achievement of WACE
- Competence in English
- Achieving a Tertiary Entrance Rank (ATAR)
- Pre-requisite subjects for your proposed university/TAFEWA studies.



If you feel you **do not** meet these criteria, but wish to return to study, we encourage you to contact Tim Hardy-Atkins at Student Services on 9351 5645 and make an appointment .

All applicants will be contacted by telephone within five (5) working days of Canning College's receipt of the "**April Start Application Form**". At this time we will either invite you to make an enrolment appointment with us or ask you to come and see us so we can clarify any concerns we have regarding your application.

When you come for your enrolment appointment please ensure you bring the following documentation:

- Academic Statements (eg. From school, TAFEWA, Curriculum Council, TISC)
- If you were born overseas bring evidence of Australian Citizenship or Permanent Residency as stated in your passport.
- Supporting documentation regarding any disabilities or medical conditions that may affect your learning.
- For your enrolment to proceed, all fees must be paid at the time of the enrolment interview.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- There is **NO** guarantee of April Start Year 12 places.
- All enrolments are conditional on the availability of places.
- Refund in full if your course does not run.

Applications for local April Start Year 12 must be received between Monday 8 March and Monday 29 March at 4:00pm.

Applications received after this date will NOT be considered in the initial allocation of students to class places.

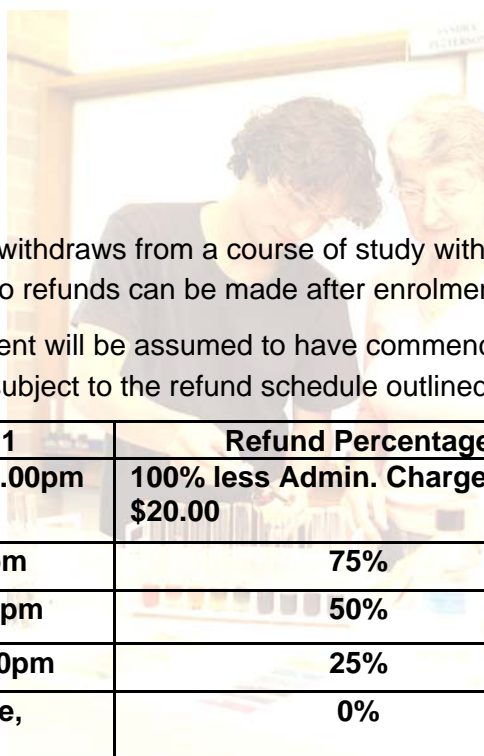
APRIL START REFUND POLICY 2010

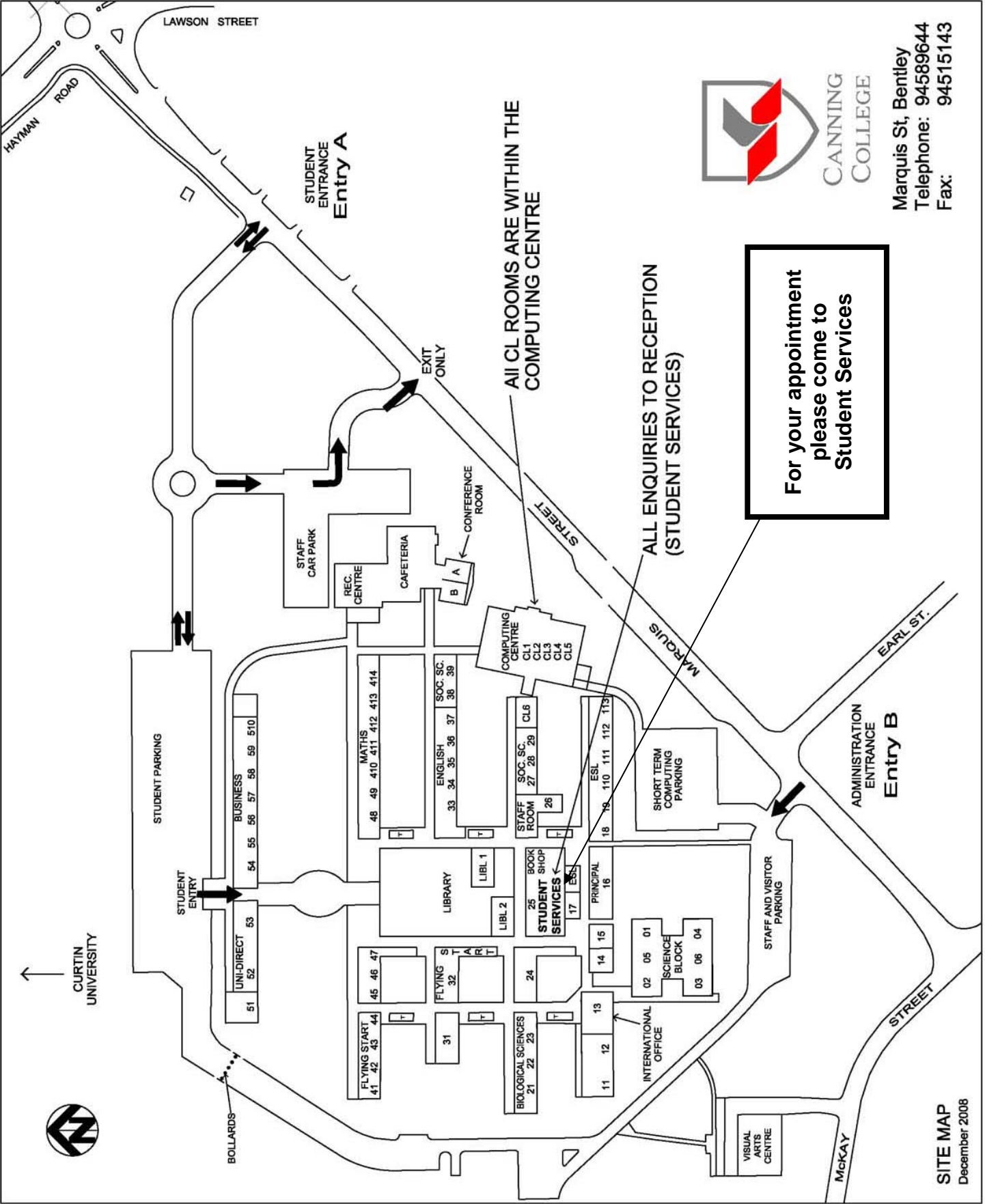
COLLEGE REFUND POLICY

Pro rata refunds of course fees will only be made if a student withdraws from a course of study within eight weeks of the commencement of April Start. For short courses no refunds can be made after enrolments close.

If you avail yourself of the early enrolment system your enrolment will be assumed to have commenced from the first day of your course of studies. You will, therefore, be subject to the refund schedule outlined below:

Withdrawal Deadline	Normal Date, Term 1	Refund Percentage
Before first day of Term 1	Tuesday 20 April, 4.00pm	100% less Admin. Charge of \$20.00
Within 3 weeks of commencement	Friday 7 May, 4.00pm	75%
Within 6 weeks of commencement	Friday 28 May, 4.00pm	50%
Within 8 weeks of commencement	Friday 11 June, 4.00pm	25%
After 8 weeks from commencement	After Friday 11 June, 4.00pm	0%
