- All Bridging programs
- Year 11 (January and April Entry)

Commissions for Certificate IV and Diplomas remain as for 2008 (20% & 15% respectively).

The awards will cover A\$5,000 of the course fee—making the course fee only A\$8,500.

Which courses are offered??

1. **April Entry Foundation Program***: leading successful students to a **guaranteed place** at The University of Western Australia, Curtin University, Murdoch University and Edith Cowan University, as well as access to universities in other Australian cities and overseas.

2. **April Entry Year 11 (Bridging)**: providing ideal preparation for further studies at Foundation, Certificate IV and Diploma level.

3. **Certificate IV (Commerce)** - 6 month course leading to direct entry to certain university courses and **guaranteed places** in Canning's Diploma of Commerce: UWA Stream or Curtin Stream.

* Special **Curtin Stream Foundation** is also offered for April Entry.

PERFORMANCE OF 2008 FOUNDATION STUDENTS

Students with a CPS of 80% or higher (ie a TER 98 +): 53 students;
27% of Canning students within the top 2% of all Year 12 level students.

Students who met university English literacy requirement: **80%**

Students who received a UWA offer requirement: 126 students (**63%**)

Canning College students scored top marks in: Economics, History, ELACS, Physical Science, Applicable Maths, Calculus, Information Systems.

70% of UWA's offers for WAUF Program students went to Canning College students.
