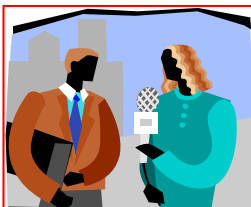


SPECIAL ITEM FOR INDONESIAN AGENTS

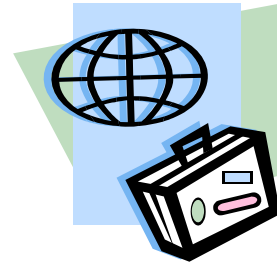
